GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA)

Each course letter grade is converted into the specific number of grade value associated with the grade. Grade Point Average (GPA) is calculated by multiplying the grade value of earned grade by the number of credits for each course and by dividing the total grade points by the total number of semester credits. The semesterwise GPA is indicated as SGPA.

CUMULATIVE GRADE POINT AVERAGE (CGPA)

CGPA is calculated at the end of the programme. The overall performance is reported by CGPA, which is a weighted average, calculated as follows:

$$CGPA = (c_1 g_1 + c_2 g_2 + c_3 g_3 + \dots) / (c_1 + c_2 + c_3 + \dots)$$

where $c_1, c_2, c_3 \dots$ denote credits associated with the course and $g_1, g_2, g_3 \dots$ denote grade values of the grades earned by the student in the respective course.

The CGPA defines the overall performance category:
