LETTER GRADING SYSTEM:

At the end of each semester, students are awarded letter grades which are based on grade scores obtained in various segments of the course evaluation. Final evaluation of the course is carried out on a four point grading system, as shown below

GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA):

Each course letter grade is converted into the specific number of grade value associated with the grade. Grade Point Average (GPA) is calculated by multiplying the grade value of earned grade by the number of credits for each course and dividing the total grade points by the total number of semester credits. The GPA must be 2.00 or above at the end of each semester. The semesterwise GPA is indicated as SGPA.

CUMULATIVE GRADE POINT AVERAGE (CGPA):

CGPA is calculated at the end of the programme. The overall performance is reported by CGPA, which is a weighted average, calculated as follows:

$$CGPA = (c_1 g_1 + c_2 g_2 + c_3 g_3 + \dots) / (c_1 + c_2 + c_3 + \dots)$$

where $c_1, c_2, c_3, \dots$ denote credits associated with the course and $g_1, g_2, g_3, \dots$ denote grade values of the grades earned by the student in the respective course.

The CGPA defines the overall performance category:

For Graduation a student has to meet the following requirements:

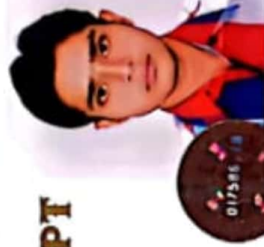
1. Satisfactory completion of all courses prescribed for the particular area of study in which the degree is to be granted.
