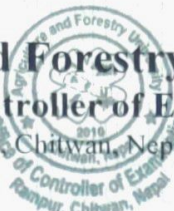

Academic Session:

One academic year is divided into two semesters. Semester is a period of start of classes to the end of the final examinations. A semester will cover a period of 18 weeks in which, 16 weeks are for of effective teaching and 2 weeks for examinations.

Credit unit:

Each unit of credit carries at least 15 semester hours for instruction. Each credit hour represents one hour for theory class per week and three hours of laboratories or field work per week.

Requirement for degree:

Cumulative grade point average (CGPA) should be 2.5 for Master. If he/she has less than the passing CGPA, the student would disqualify to get the degree. However, he/she can reappear in any subjects of his/her choice till he/she attains the minimum required CGPA to get the degree. No division will be allotted in PhD degree. However, transcript of course work with grade will be provided and should have 3.0 passing CGPA.

Examination Systems: There will be 3 examinations for each course (Theory as well as practical). Internal assessments 40 % and final 60 % (External).

Residential Requirements:

All the students must meet the residential requirements of at least one and half years. However, Ph D students under category of degree by research should get advice from the advisory committee regarding residential requirements.
