Technicians with the Wildlife & Domestic Veterinary Programme have been taught by the Senior Veterinary Adviser to take medical histories, examine animals appropriately, apply suitable methods of restraint, recognise symptoms of a wide variety of diseases and know preventive and curative procedures to control them. They also were trained in pregnancy diagnosis and surgical techniques. In addition, the technicians were trained to carry out relevant laboratory diagnostic procedures and to collect samples correctly and, to this end, two courses in laboratory techniques were organised with the cooperation of the microbiologist from the Institute of Zoology, Zoological Society of London, U.K.
