Credits:

- * Courses offered any semester can carry a weightage of 1 to 15 credits
- * 1 credit is equivalent to a minimum of 15 contact hours in each semester

Letter Grading System:

At the end of each semester, students are awarded letter grades which are based on grades and scores obtained in various segments of the course evaluation. Final evaluation of the course is carried out on a four point grading system, as follows:

Grade Point Average (GPA):

Each course grade is converted into the specific number of grade value associated with the grade. Grade Point Average (GPA) is calculated by multiplying the grade value of the earned grade by the number of credits for each course and dividing the total grade points by total number of semester credits. The GPA must be 2.0 or above at the end of each semester.

Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA):

The overall performance is reported by CGPA, which is a weighted average, calculated as follows:

$$CGPA = (c_1g_1 + c_2g_2 + c_3g_3 + \dots) / (c_1 + c_2 + c_3 + \dots)$$

Where $c_1, c_2, \dots$ denote credits associated with the course and $g_1, g_2, \dots$ denote grade values of the grades earned by the student in the respective courses.

The CGPA defines the overall performance category:

<u>CGPA</u>	<u>Performance</u>
3.5 to 4.0	Distinction
3.0 to less than 3.5	First Division
2.0 less than 3.0	Second Division
Less than 2.0	Fail

Graduate requirements:

For graduation a students must earn a
