Mr. Chiranjiwi worked for RIMS-Nepal from 25th December 2017 to 30th June 2023 as Livestock Technician (LT). RIMS-Nepal was founded in 2001 as a non-Profit and non-governmental organization by development professionals. It works in Nepal for the poor and marginalized community's, climate change adaptation (CCA) and disaster risk reduction (DRR); energy, health and sanitation, agriculture and food security by managing resources, building capacity, promoting social justice, and developing multi-stakeholder partnerships in partnering with USAID, UNDP, DCA, CARE-Nepal, Heifer Nepal and ADRA-Nepal.

Initially Mr. Acharya was recruited as Livestock Technician (LT) for Food Security Enhancement and Agriculture Resilience of the Earthquake Affected Rural Nepalese Farmers (FOSTER-II) Program Funded by Canadian Foodgrains Bank (CFGB), ADRA Canada and partnership with ADRA Nepal under RIMS-Nepal.

His major responsibilities included:

- Provide technical support to farmers on livestock raising-animal husbandry feed, shed, health management and marketing.
- Organize farmers field school classes.
- Form a mechanism for regular meetings and interactions between livestock producer farmers' groups and affiliate the groups with cooperatives.
- Facilitate the monthly meetings of farmers and proper documentation of decisions.
- Support the groups for the preparation of mineral blocks, preparation nurseries of grass and fodders, improvements of sheds and stables and other works related to project.
- Facilitation for the marketing of goods and services produced by the groups with mobilization of resources and effective coordination with stakeholders as per the project guidelines.
- to project coordinator and inform works and activities performed by the project to ward and other related offices periodically and include in ward/Municipal plans.
- Make linkage and coordination with municipal level stakeholders for resource collaboration.
- Support the livelihoods of marginalized / poor families through the maximum use of local resources.
- Work as per the suggestions of organization and project coordinator.
- Document and share the good learning and practices.
- Provide essential support to the monitoring, reviews, and studies of multi-stakeholders.

Thus, Mr. Acharya was one of the key pillars in making the RIMS-Nepal managed project successful. The organization is proud of Mr. Acharya and would like to lend him a hand in future. I have no reservation to recommend him for the similar and more challenging job of same nature in any organization.

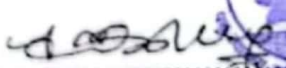
